Screen Resolution Sizes - What is HD, FHD, QHD, UHD, 4K...

The three HDTV resolutions are 720p, 1080i, and 1080p. The number stands for the number of horizontal lines that create the image. The letter describes the type of scan used by the TV to display the picture: progressive or interlaced. Resolution matters because more lines mean a better picture.

720p vs. 1080i vs. 1080p

720p Resolution TV = 1280 x 720 progressive scan. (Total pixels = 921,600) 1080i Resolution TV = 1920 x 1080 split into 2 interlaced fields of 540 lines. (Total pixels = 2,073,600)

For many displays, this means a native resolution (the display's intrinsic resolution) of at least 1280 x 720 pixels. Higher native resolution is better, with so called "full HD resolution" being 1920 x 1080 pixels.

HDTV Past, Present and Future - Part I History

Upscaling mathematically matches the pixel count of the DVD output signal to the physical pixel count on an HDTV, which is typically 1280 x 720 (720p), 1920 x 1080 (1080i or 1080p), or 3840 x 2160 (2160p or 4K). 720p represents 1,280 pixels displayed across the screen horizontally and 720 pixels down the screen vertically.
